remember -ing	recordar (o-ue) acordarse de (o-ue)
repent	arrepentirse de (e-ie)
resist	resistir
resume	retomar comenzar otra vez
risk	arriesgarse a
suggest I suggest taking the bus. but: I suggest that you take the bus.	sugerir (e-ie) hacer algo
It's no good trying to talk to him. It's no use giving him advice. It`s not worth going there. There`s no point in waiting any more.	No vale la pena... No tiene sentido...
It's (really) worth seeing Stuttgart.	Vale la pena...
It's good seeing you again.	Es bueno...
